

MONTHLY REPORT – NOVEMBER 2018



- Business licenses were approved for 6 home-based businesses.

- The Powhatan Chamber Pop-Up Shop is selling various local home based business products for a limited time.
- Staff visited the Powhatan High School Career and Technical Education classrooms to familiarize themselves with the emerging workforce, skill sets and the training programs offered by the school.
- A CUP for a carwash next to Land & Coates received approval by the Board of Supervisors.
- The Board approved amendments to Winterfield Place II's rezoning, which is proposed to include 75,000 s.f. of high quality retail/commercial/office space.
